## LTS National Honor Society Donates \$1800

Dorset, VT—This fall, Long Trail School's National Honor Society began selling ornaments made by the Famine Relief Beading Project, which is one effort of the Vermont-based BOMA Fund. The Project is a fulltime business venture for the women's groups located in 6 villages in northern Kenya. It provides income and economic independence to their members. The brightly colored animal-shaped ornaments were made from the tanned hides of animals that died in the 2006 drought. After selling the ornaments at the Dorset Farmer's Market and at theater performances, the LTS NHS chapter has collected over \$1,800 for this cause. Long Trail School's NHS Chapter focuses on community service and aims to balance its efforts between local, national and international causes.
