Empty Bowls Invites Skaters and Bowlers

Dorset, VT—On January 25th from 7.15 pm to 9.15pm, Empty Bowls at Long Trail School invites the public for skating and bowl-making opportunity at Riley Rink at Hunter Park. This event is free and all ages are welcome. Bowl-making will be available in the warm-up room.

Empty Bowls at Long Trail School is a community-wide effort to raise funds for local causes. During the months of January and February, the public is invited to numerous bowl-making sessions. The goal for 2008 is to make 1000 bowls. Instruction, clay and firing are provided. Then, on April 5th, all bowls are used during a dinner at Long Trail School. The cost for the dinner is \$10 per person, for which they receive a bowl, soup, bread and dessert donated by area restaurants.
