Drama and Song at LTS

Dorset, VT—On March 14 and 15, at 7:00 pm, a performance of Long Trail School's Middle School drama class, followed by musical numbers, will be open to the public.

The one act play, "Making Nice," is a comedy by Vermont Playwright Alan Haehnel and is directed by Carrie Anne Smith, a junior from Pawlet, assisted by Kinsey Gates, a junior from Manchester. The play, featuring 18 middle school drama students, is a comedy about a neurotic director with a very short fuse. She loses all patience with her cast and crew the night before the show opens. Two people from the organization OSHAT (which is OSHA, theatre division) appear at the theater. They want to shut down the show for the safety of the actors because they feel the director has created a too toxic environment for them to work. Therefore the Director, Cast and Crew must persuade these people that the Director truly can "make nice" for the sake of the show.

After the one act play there will be some brief musical performances by students in grades six through twelve. The selections will include both solos and group numbers, which will feature pop songs, Broadway hits and some opera.
