LONG TRAIL SCHOOL BOASTS NATIONAL MERIT RECOGNITION

Dorset--- Long Trail School is very proud to announce that two seniors have been recognized for their performance on the National Merit Scholar Qualifying Test. Jessica Carr, senior, has been designated a National Merit Scholarship Semifinalist. Additionally, senior Kodi Ross received commendation for his strong score. Since 2000, Long Trail has had at least one student receive commendation or higher status.

The National Merit Scholarship Competition is driven by PSAT scores. Initially more than 1.4 million test takers enter the competition. After review, this group is narrowed to 16,000 Semifinalists, who represent the highest 1% in each state level. Of these students, 15,000 continue to Finalist status. Finalists are selected based on their test scores, an essay, grades, contributions to school and community, and recommendations.
